

Committee Goals

- > Raise \$26,250 by June 30, 2023
- Add 10 new donors by June 30, 2023

- Secured \$25,763 in donations (75 donors, \$343 gift average)
- Added 23 new donors over past two years
- FY23 was second largest annual revenue total in JASAN history
- An additional \$7,250 raised to support 2023 PSHOF efforts (12 donors)

Committee Goals 2023-24

- Secure gifts from 35-40% of membership (last year 75 donors=25% response)
